DiMARTINO ~ ROBINSON

The two artists we hear today are faculty members at the University of Kentucky. The Duo is dedicated to performing the finest literature from all periods, with emphasis on Baroque, Contemporary, and American music.

During the 1984-85 season the Duo performed a series of 9 concerts in 8 states under sponsorship of a prestigious Solo Recitalist Fellowship Grant, competitively awarded by the National Endowment for the Arts "to recognize America's outstanding performing musicians" and to support the national series of concerts and workshops.

In addition to the performance of an extensive body of literature for this unique combination of instruments, the Duo has also commissioned several new compositions and has performed a number of original arrangements with hopes for future publication. Future tours are being planned for the United States and Europe, as well.

VINCENT DiMARTINO has gained an international reputation as a Jazz trumpeter and has recently been featured as soloist with the Cincinnati Symphony at Carnegie Hall, New York and with other orchestras in the United States and abroad. He is in constant demand as conductor of masterclasses and clinics at major universities.

SCHUYLER ROBINSON has concertized extensively in the eastern and southern states and in Germany and England, and has conducted workshops, masterclasses and recitals for colleges, universities and chapters of the American Guild of Organists. For the A.G.O. he has performed on three Regional Conventions and serves as Dean of the Lexington, Ky. Chapter.
