Matthew DIRST was born in Chicago in 1961. Following studies at the University of Illinois (Bachelor of Music, 1983) and at Southern Methodist University (Master of Music, Master of Sacred Music, 1985), he received a Fulbright scholarship for study in France. A student of Marie-Claire Alain and of Huguette Dreyfus at the Conservatoire National de Rueil-Malmaison, he was awarded unanimous first prizes in organ in 1986 and in harpsichord in 1987.

A laureate of numerous international organ competitions, including Nuremberg in 1987 and Dublin in 1986, Matthew Dirst was a finalist in the 10th Grand Prix de Chartres in 1986 (in Interpretation). Recent engagements have included concerts in England, Ireland, France, Germany, and the United States. He is currently a doctoral student at Stanford University, where he holds a university teaching fellowship.
